RMIAN's Children's Program directly represents children who have survived abandonment, abuse, persecution or other violence, and provides technical assistance and community education throughout the State on children's immigration law issues. Unable to meet the overwhelming need for legal services, RMIAN refers both detention and children's cases to its network of pro bono attorneys. RMIAN screens pro bono cases, writes referral memorandums, and provides professional liability insurance and a mentor attorney for each pro bono attorney.

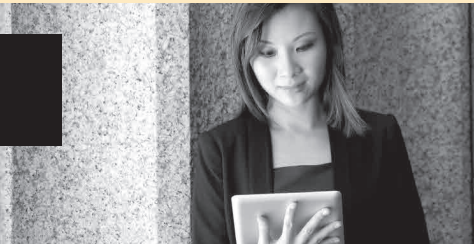
