Multilateral trade and financial sanctions against the Islamic Republic of Iran are expected to be reduced sometime early this year to implement the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action agreement between Iran and the permanent UN Security Council members and Germany (the so-called "P5+1"). The United States will at the outset largely maintain its own Iran unilateral sanctions with respect to US persons, meaning restrictions applicable to US companies will be different than the limits on America's foreign trading partners.

Your speaker, Frank Schuchat, has been following the long course of the P5+1 negotiations for several years. He has assisted US clients to obtain special licenses for sale of medical products and other transactions to Iran, and he has represented a substantial number of clients in US law enforcement investigations of Iran sanctions violations.
