Also included is a discussion of witness rehabilitation. Rehabilitation is the technique of restoring a witness's credibility after it has been discredited or impeached by other evidence. This segment addresses fact witness rehabilitation following impeachment, which casts doubt on a witness's credibility.

This segment addresses a number of exceptions to the hearsay rule that relate to the declarant's state of mind. Each of these topics is addressed through an introduction to the basic principles and applicable law, an outline of the elements required for an adequate foundation, and a sample examination.
